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White Wines

Founders Stone Chardonnay - 1 187ml Single Serve £
South Eastern Australia

Fresh, ripe Chardonnay flavours of melon and peaches. A rich, creamy texture with a rounded crisp finish. A touch of light oak adds a subtle buttery finish. V, VE, GF

Jack Rabbit Sauvignon Blanc - 1 187ml Single Serve £
Central Valley, Chile.

Crisp and refreshing with bright citrus flavours such as lemon, grapefruit and lime. It may also have hints of tropical fruits like passion fruit or pineapple. The wine typically exhibits a lively acidity and clean zesty finish.

Jack Rabbit Pinot Grigio - 2 187ml Single Serve £
IGP Terre Siciliane, Italy

A light to medium bodied white wine with flavours of citrus fruits like lemon and grapefruit. It often features crisp acidity and refreshing notes of green apple and pear. Pinot Grigio typically has a clean dry finish.

Rose Wines

Founders Stone White Zinfandel - 6 187ml Single Serve £
California, USA

Delicate and refreshing California White Zinfandel with delicious Soft fruit flavours of strawberries, raspberries and melon. V, VE, GF

Red Wines

Founders Stone Shiraz - C
South Eastern Australia.

187ml Single Serve £

A rich, plummy and spicy nose. A soft berry palate with a rounded, long finish. Hints of Shiraz spice, with vanilla and dark chocolate on the palate. A true Aussie classic.

Jack Rabbit Merlot - B
California, USA

187ml Single Serve £

This Merlot is a medium-bodied red wine known for its soft and approachable character. It offers flavours of ripe red fruits such as cherries and plums, along with hints of blackberries and spices. The tannins are typically smooth, and the wine can have a velvety texture.

Sparkling Wine

Botter Prosecco - 2
Veneto, Italy.

200ml Single Serve £

This Prosecco has a delicious refreshing fizz and loads of lively bubbles. Typical Italian Prosecco Spumante, crisp delicate perlage. Pale light yellow colour, delicate and complex bouquet with fruity notes that remind of peach, green apple with second notes of acacia and lilac. Fresh and light on the palate with balanced acidity and body; harmonic with long persistent aftertaste. V, VE, GF

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A bit about our Wines

We have compiled a varied selection of wines from around the world, which we trust you will enjoy. With this in mind our selection includes wines from:-

California - Jack Rabbit

Jack Rabbit Vineyards are owned and operated by Thurow Vineyards, a small organic vineyard located in Southern California. With a background in Rheinland German wines, Ursula and Dieter Thurow opened the California winery in 1997. They began with 6.5 acres of preexisting Zinfandel vines and added on three acres of Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Merlot, Petit Verdot, and Malbec. Their award winning Zinfandel has been rated well by Robert Parker and received gold and silver medals at the West Coast Wine competition. At the Long Beach Grand Cru, their Cabernet Sauvignon won a silver medal and the Late Harvest Zinfandel was chosen Chairman's Best.

Veneto Italy - Botter

Climate - Temperate, mitigated by the sea, the chain of the Alps protects it from the northern winds. Winters are cold and wet, summers are hot and sultry with medium temperature excursions.

Verification - The soft pressed juice is stored in stainless steel tanks for static cold decanting. Once the clean juice is racked and inoculated with selected yeasts, it will go through fermentation at a controlled constant temperature of 18°C within 8/10 days. After a storage period, the winemaker studies a skilled coupage to achieve the Prosecco Spumante base cuvée.

Subsequently the base wine is filtered and additioned of saccharose and selected yeasts to undergo second fermentation (Martinotti – Charmat method) at a controlled temperature of 14-15°C in a pressure tank. Once required pressure, alcohol and sugar level are reached the wine is refrigerated, cold stabilized (-2/-3°C), filtered and controlled before bottling.

Taste Guide

Champagne, White & Rose wines are designated numbers from 1 to 9, with 1 being the driest and 9 being the sweetest.

Red wines are designated letters from A to E, with A being the lightest and E being the deepest and fullest.
